Under this agreement for 2019
Manly State School will receive

\$213,209*

This funding will be used to

- improve the performance of Year 3 students in Reading Mean Scale Score from 71st percentile to 75th percentile.
- improve the performance of Year 5 students in Spelling Mean Scale Score from the 60th percentile to the 64th percentile.
- improve internal reading data from 81%% to 85% of Year 3 students attaining Regional Reading Standards for targeting Upper Two Bands in Reading.
- ensure all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students attain Regional Reading Standards for National Minimum Standard in all year levels.

Our initiatives include

- continuing to implement guided reading programs in Years Prep, 1 and 2.
- ensuring consistency in whole school planning processes regarding spelling, phonics, grammar, vocabulary and comprehension.
- implementing a whole school spelling program.
- using the Inquiry cycle to enable year level teaching teams to analyse reading and writing outcomes.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- releasing teachers to participate in year level case management meetings every term - \$51,000
- implementing Head of Curriculum teacher responsible for monitoring the enactment of curriculum - \$86,000.
- employing teacher aides to provide targeted reading support to students in prep – Year 3 - \$76,209.
