Student Uniform and Dress Code

The Manly State School community strongly advocates the universal wearing of school uniforms by students Prep to Year 6/7. This code has been endorsed by, the school's Parents and Citizens Association.

The wearing of the school uniform supports:

- A safe learning environment by enabling ready identification of students;
- The elimination of competition in dress / fashion at school;
- A sense of belonging and minimizing visible evidence of economics or social difference.

Students are expected to wear school uniform when:

- Attending or representing the school;
- Participating in school excursions and field trips;
- Travelling to and from school; or
- Engaging in school activities and events out of school hours.

The school uniform, as currently adopted by the P&C, is as follows:

Prep Students (Boys and Girls)

- Royal blue knit unisex shorts with school polo shirt
- Black school shoes OR sports jogger style shoes in black
- White anklet sports socks
- Royal blue zip up jumper (Winter)
- Royal blue open leg track suit pants (Winter)

Girls' Day Uniform

- Blue tunic or;
- Blue culottes and striped blouse with school tie
- White anklet socks
- Royal blue zip up jumper (Winter)
- Navy blue tights (Winter)

Boys' Day Uniform

- Blue shirt, grey shorts
- Grey anklet socks
- Grey long trousers (Winter)
- Royal blue zip up jumper (Winter)

Sports Uniform

- Royal blue knit unisex shorts
- School polo shirt
- White anklet sock and clean jogger style shoes

Shoes

The school dress uniform is black shoes, which are required for formal occasions and some school excursions. Black lace up shoes, are mandatory for students when they are performing in school choirs and instrumental music performances.

Students may wear clean jogger style shoes or black school shoes for normal school day activity.

Thongs or clog style shoes are not suitable for school.

Hats

A school hat with the school emblem is an integral part of the school uniform. For sun safety, students are required to wear a school hat whenever they are involved in sport or outside activity. No hat, no play!
